

LaFinca Golf Etiquette Rules

For the proper functioning of the club and so that all members and their guests can enjoy a pleasant experience when using the golf club, the etiquette rules must be respected, both in the clubhouse and on and off the golf course. Members are responsible for their guests in all respects.

At all times, polite behaviour must be encouraged among members, with guests and with all club staff, and vice versa.

- The clothing used in the club must be appropriate, not allowing the use of jeans or tracksuit trousers on the course, sleeveless or collarless shirts for men, or strap tops for women, nor wearing the golf cap backwards. The use of golf shoes is mandatory on the golf course, although **shoes with metal spikes are not allowed**.
- Games are made up of a maximum of 4 players.
- On the course, divots that may be made must be replaced, and if that is not possible, divots must be filled with sand, both on the tee and on the fairway. On the greens, trolleys may not circulate, nor may anyone walk through areas marked with ropes, and all pitch marks must be repaired. Bunkers, whether on the fairway or around the greens, must be raked.
- In the buggies, no more than 2 people or more than 2 golf bags may ride, and they must circulate only through the areas of the course designated for this purpose, following the instructions shown on the screens for proper circulation.
- On the course, play times must be respected, with a 9-hole round expected to last 2 hours and 15 minutes. If, for any reason, play times cannot be respected, the group must let the game behind play through. It will be mandatory to do so when a complete hole has been lost in relation to the group ahead, provided that the group behind consists of at least 3 players. Marshals will be attentive to play times and will warn groups that do not respect them. If, during a round, a group has been warned more than twice about the play time and has not let others play through, the marshal may require that group to skip a hole or exclude them from continuing play.
- Both on the course and on the driving range, it is requested that conversations be kept at a low volume so as not to disturb other members or guests in their enjoyment of the game, lesson, or training.
- On the driving range, the areas reserved for different uses and the signs or indications from the staff for the use of grass or mat tees must be observed.
- The accompaniment of pets is allowed in the clubhouse and on the golf course, but it is recommended that they remain on a leash at all times. If any pet disturbs the peace of the clubhouse or the golf course, or bothers other members or their guests, the club staff may ask the person responsible for the pet to keep it by their side or to remove it from the premises.
- Families with children under 10 years old are asked to pay attention, especially in the clubhouse and particularly in the restaurant, to their children's behavior, so that all members can enjoy the facilities peacefully and family relationships can coexist with the enjoyment of those who do not have children with them at that time.

If any member or guest is warned at any time about an infraction of any of the etiquette rules, whether by another member or by club staff, the person concerned is asked to accept the warning in good faith and comply with any instructions given. If they believe there is no basis for the warning, they are requested to report it to the marshals if it occurs on the course or to the member service staff if it occurs in the clubhouse.

Any member may communicate to the member service staff any comments, incidents, or suggestions they may have regarding these rules or their application.

It is important to remember that these rules are designed to promote coexistence and the proper functioning of the club. We hope that members and their guests enjoy their experience at LaFinca Golf and that guests feel welcome at all times.
